RESOLUTION 26-26

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION APPOINTING AARON ZUHL AS ACTING POLICE CHIEF FOR THE VILLAGE OF COVINGTON

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Mayor, Council appoints Aaron Zuhl as the Acting Police Chief for the Village of Covington;

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Village of Covington is authorized by the Ohio Revised Code to appoint the Police Chief and is appointing Aaron Zuhl as the Acting Police Chief, effective May 18, 2026; and

WHEREAS, as part of said appointment, it is necessary for Council to adjust Aaron Zuhl's salary to compensate him for the additional duties he will undertake as Acting Police Chief; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by two-thirds of the Legislative Authority of the Village of Covington, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: Aaron Zuhl is hereby appointed Acting Police Chief and shall perform said duties until he resigns, is terminated, or a permanent Police Chief is appointed, and he or she commences the duties of Police Chief.

SECTION 2: During the time period that Aaron Zuhl is fulfilling the Acting Police Chief duties, he shall receive an additional weekly pay of \$300.00 per week; for clarification purposes said increase in pay shall be in addition to the pay he receives as Police Sergeant.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force effective May 18, 2026, and an emergency has been declared to pass said resolution.
