ORDINANCE 12-26

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SCHOOL ZONE FOR TRAFFIC PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Village of Covington desired to expand the school zone on Chestnut Street;

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation conducted a study and authorized a school zone on Chestnut St extending from the Village's eastern line of Chestnut Street to the Eastern line of Ullery Drive (exhibit A).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Legislative Authority of the Village of Covington, State of Ohio, with a majority affirming, that:

SECTION 1: The Village of Covington approves the school zone recommended by the Ohio Department of Transportation, described above hereto, and attached as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2: Anyone violating the speed limits within the above-described school zone shall be subject to the penalties prescribed in the Ohio Revised Code and the Ohio Municipal Code for speeding within a school zone.

SECTION 3: All resolutions and Ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed or modified to conform with this ordinance.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date provided by law.
