ORDINANCE 08-26

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL PART OF ORDINANCE NO. 16-24.

WHEREAS, the Village of Covington adopted ordinance No.16-24 establishing the installation of certain stop signs within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Covington has reviewed and analyzed the installation of said signs and does not believe that certain stop signs are necessary and they should not be placed in the Village;

WHEREAS, the stop signs listed in Exhibit A shall not be installed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Legislative Authority of the Village of Covington, State of Ohio, with a majority affirming, that:

SECTION 1: The Village of Covington Ordinance NO. 16-24 shall be repealed in part to remove stop signs listed in attached Exhibit A from said Ordinance and after removal of these signs, the Ordinance shall be reaffirmed; and

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date provided by law.
