RESOLUTION 42-26

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO SUBMIT
AN APPLICATION FOR AN OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT GRANT
AND IN SUPPORT**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio through the Ohio Department of Development, administers financial assistance for brownfield sites across Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Covington desires to apply for financial assistance from the Ohio Department of Development, specifically the Brownfield Remediation Program, to demolish, abate, and redevelop the old Sellman's Warehouse to allow it to be redeveloped to bring economic development opportunities to the Village of Covington downtown; and

WHEREAS, if the Village of Covington receives said grant, it would be used for the demolition, reconstruction, and redevelopment of the old Sellman's Warehouse Property located within Covington; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Authority of the Village of Covington, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: that the Village of Covington's Council approves the filing of an application for financial assistance with the Ohio Department of Development; and

Section 2: it is the understanding and of the Council that the Village Administrator has applied for the Brownfield Remediation Program and the Council wishes to publicly support the application; and

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
